Subject: Faculty Senate Action re Faculty Trustee Election

Ms. Prioleau and Ms. Jones:

The Governance Committee in a session called by the Faculty Senate Parliamentarian ruled (1) that Associate and Assistant Deans are ineligible to run for Faculty Trustee, and therefore, (2) that the current Faculty Trustee ballot is invalid and cannot be used in the voting for Faculty Trustee. Pursuant to these rulings, the Governance Committee recommended that the Committee on Committees should convene as soon as possible to prepare a new ballot for the Faculty Trustee election, with the name of Moses Garuba removed from the ballot for the remainder of the Faculty Trustee election.

The Council, which met this morning, voted to accept the recommendation. I reminded the Council that all procedural changes to the Faculty Trustee election would require review and approval by the Secretary of the Board. However, I was strongly opposed, and the Council directed me to inform the Secretary of the action that has been taken to issue a new ballot, minus the name of Moses Garuba.

The Committee on Committees will meet on Monday to execute its charge to amend the ballot for Faculty Trustee. I await your response, including any directives that might be shared with the Council and Committee on Committees regarding the Faculty Trustee election.
