Dear Members of the Board of Trustees of Howard University:

This letter is to inform you of the results of the Full Faculty Senate vote on the “No Confidence” Resolution of the Faculty Senate Council, held from April 4th through April 10th, 2018.

Thirty percent of the 962 full-time Howard University Faculty members eligible to vote cast their ballots in this referendum as follows:

- 61% of the Faculty voted “No Confidence” in President Wayne A.I. Frederick;
- 52% of the Faculty voted “No Confidence” in Provost Anthony K. Wutoh;
- 55% of the Faculty voted “No Confidence” in Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer Tashni-Ann Dubroy;
- 61% of the Faculty voted “No Confidence” in the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees.

This is the largest known voter turnout by Howard University Faculty on any issue in many years. The results are consistent with the April 2nd, 2018 vote of the Faculty Senate Council; the Council is the elected legislative body that represents Faculty within all academic units of the University. This outcome reflects the concurrence of the Faculty with the attached Resolution.

We anticipate your response by Monday, April 23rd, 2018, specifically as it relates to leadership transition and changes as expressed in the Resolution.
