Dear Colleagues,

It may be useful to remember the official position of the HU Faculty Senate since April 2018. Please see the attached letter sent to the Board of Trustees years ago. This position has not been rescinded and still stands. Also, it should be understood that the faculty warned the Board that they should expect continued administrative failures if a transition was not made.

To summarize the letter, the following excerpt is from the 2018 senate email sent through HU communications:

“In the Spring 2018 semester, based on the decisions and practices of the Howard University Board of Trustees and the Administration, the Faculty Senate Council and Faculty Senate at-large voted “No Confidence” in the Executive Committee of the Board, and in the Administrative officers (Dr. Wayne A.I. Frederick, President; Tashni-Ann Dubroy Ph.D., EVP/COO; and Anthony K. Wutoh Ph.D., Provost/CAO.)

As a response to these votes, in a letter dated April 20, 2018, to the Board, the Council of the Faculty Senate asked for the resignation of the aforementioned individuals; and requested that a process and timeline for change/transition of University leadership be initiated.”
