Good afternoon, colleagues.

The Council is pleased to note that the non-tenure track faculty have reaffirmed the AAUP position that more tenured positions strengthen academic freedom for their contract proposal to the HU Administration. The Council also believes it is long since time for the HU Administration to begin to negotiate in good faith with the NTT union. It is time for a resolution. In this spirit, the FS Council approved the following motion:

The Council supports the non-tenure track faculty union's proposal to create clear pathways for career status positions for faculty who have exhibited teaching excellence. We believe this would strengthen the university, improve faculty retention and relations, and improve students' learning experience.
