Good afternoon colleagues,

Our colleagues in the NTT faculty union, a number of tenured and tenure track faculty, students, and alums are planning actions over the next two weeks. Please consider participating. Also, please discuss with your colleagues in your departments, schools, and colleges.

It looks like things will begin on Wednesday 3/16. By request, I attended a meeting with them yesterday. Here is what they've laid out.

[Wednesday 3/16: At 10:30 a.m. faculty, students, alumni and others in solidarity will meet at the circle in the middle of the yard.](#)

- At 11:00 a.m. we will proceed to the 'A' Building where we will have an open mike speak out and press conference.
- A delegation will go in to meet with Provost Wutoh and ask him to meet with the group and come to negotiations with the intent to settle the dispute
- We will announce an unfair labor practice strike on 3/23 through 3/25.
- We are asking student activists to call on students to support the strike and boycott classes during the 3-day strike
- **We are calling on supportive tenure track faculty to announce that they will not cross the picket line during the strike**

3/23 to 3/25: Unfair Labor Practice Strike if no agreement on a contract is reached.

Please consider and discuss with your colleagues: the Coalition's request of tenured and tenure track faculty to not cross the picket line during the strike.
