Full Senate Meeting Minutes

60 attendees - no quorum

Discussion items:

1. Workload policy - overcrowded classrooms and labs, lab fees not accessible to pay for supplies and equipment, need for more hires with increased enrollment, approved workload policy is being violated, no input process for faculty regarding new buildings (classrooms and labs needed to accommodate numbers of students).
2. Extra paycheck - not sure how wide spread this is. Some faculty received an extra paycheck in the summer. The administration proposed a way to pay this back to faculty. Some faculty still have questions.
3. Presidential search - Mentioned that Senate had no input into search committee formation. The only input faculty senate has had was one 60 minute listening session.

Dr. Frederick spoke from 4pm to about 4:45. Mainly about issues above. He agreed to send his slide presentation. Also questions and comments included students not paid (both on grants and departmental TA's) to date (11/4/22) from the beginning of the semester as well as incorrect invoices sent to faculty grantor and workday balances.
